CELINE

General Description

This maincrop variety produces many uniform red, oval to long oval tubers of light yellow flesh.

Expresses excellent resistance to both common and powdery scab.



Has partial resistance to potato cyst nematodes.

At the moment this variety has been grown for UK outlets for general ware, pre-pack and will also produce enough dry matter for french fries.

Export markets include Scandinavia, in particular Norway.

General Physiology:

An oval to long oval, red skinned, yellow fleshed variety, with shallow eyes.

Plant: Medium height, bushy, with many entirely pigmented stems. Blue/green, glossy, very small, strongly pigmented closed leaf.

Leaf: Medium size and shaped primary leaflets with small secondary leaflets. Terminal leaflet overlapped.

Flowers: Few light purple flowers on a strongly pigmented stem.

Berries: Few.
